



Church Planting Strategy for Bringing in the first 50 People

- Use outreach tools like "The Alpha Course" to introduce people outside the church to the Good News of Jesus
- Set a goal of having at least 100 attendees by the time of the relaunch

V. Infusion of mentoring and training

- Seek mentoring and training from experienced church planters and organizations like BCBC and BGC to help develop the skills and knowledge needed to lead the church to growth
- Continuously provide training and development opportunities for members to enhance their skills and knowledge
